

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2017

Governmental Entity: City of Aubrey

The City of Aubrey purchases natural gas from ATMOS Energy. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of 3,603 thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City of Aubrey purchases electricity from GEXA Energy and CoServ Electric. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of 1,393,300 kilowatt hours (kWh) of electricity.

The City of Aubrey is a municipal water supplier. As a self-supplier, no municipal funds are expended to purchase water for municipal services. In Calendar Year 2017, the City consumed a total of 6,798,406 gallons of water.

The City of Aubrey purchases water from Denton County Fresh Water Supply District 8B. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of 380,710 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in the calendar year of 2017 is \$211,630,.14.
