Dear City of Aubrey Water Customer,

Effective immediately, the City of Aubrey is implementing Stage 1 of the City's Water Conservation and Emergency Water Demand Management Plan. Upper Trinity Regional Water District, who supplies wholesale water to the Mustang Special Utility District to serve our Winn Ridge customers and provides an emergency connection to Aubrey Proper have implemented Stage 1 water restrictions which are effective for all Upper Trinity Regional Water District Member City's.

Our Winn Ridge customers should follow measures implemented by the Mustang Special Utility District.

Aubrey Proper Customers receive groundwater supply from a series of four water wells within the city. Water conservation practices, techniques, and technologies that reduce the consumption of water help to ensure adequate water supply is available for our future.

Under Stage 1 water restrictions, customers are requested to voluntarily limit outdoor water use. Customers are requested to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscaped areas to Sundays and Thursdays for customers with a street address ending in an even number (0, 2, 4, 6 or 8), and Saturdays and Wednesdays for water customers with a street address ending in an odd number (1, 3, 5, 7 or 9), and to irrigate landscapes only between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. on designated watering days.

Water customers are requested to practice water conservation and to minimize or discontinue water use for nonessential purposes. Upper Trinity Regional Water District anticipates this measure to be effective for the remainder of the summer and we appreciate your assistance in helping to conserve water.
