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This Year's parade theme is all about Aubrey Pridel. Come ready to show your Aubrey and Chaparral spirit.

All parade entries have the opportunity to win one of 4 awards:

- 1) Mayors Choice
- 2) School Spirit
- 3) Originality – creativeness and originality of the entry
- 4) Difficulty – difficulty of construction, level of effort

Check-In begins at 8:00 a.m. – Parade order will be determined by order of arrival.

- Due to limited staging space, groups that wish to be lined up together must arrive together.
- The parade will start at the Middle School parking lot.
- When you arrive, please be patient with parade volunteers and follow their directions.
- All ATVs and non-street-legal vehicles must be brought on a trailer to parade staging area and must be immediately returned to the trailer at end of parade.
- Participant Cards received at check-in MUST be clearly displayed or you may be asked to remove your vehicle/entry from the parade.
- All parade participant's (including marching band, walkers, cars and floats) line up at the Aubrey Middle School on FM 428.

Horses and wagons, please use parking lot and grassy area to the west of the middle school. Horse Entries – Come prepared to dispose of your own manure. Please do not leave horse manure on the parking lot or public areas. Please do not leave trash, streamers, bottles, etc. on the school grounds. Either place in trash receptacles provided or keep inside float.



Judging Begins at 9:00 a.m. – Entries arriving after the judging has started will not be included in the judging.

Parade starts at 10:00 a.m. – Parade order will be as follows:

- Parade Dignitaries
- Marching Bands, Color Guard
- Motorcycles
- Golf Carts, ATV;s
- Cars and Light Trucks without Trailers
- Trucks with Trailers, Floats and Large Vehicles
- Horse and Rider and Horse-Drawn Entries

Award winner will be announced on Main Street as the winning entries pass by the podium.

#### PARADE ROUTE

Start at the Middle School along FM 428, Turn Right at Main, Turn Right at Chestnut. Do Not Proceed straight on 428 to Hwy 377 or Magnolia Street  
**Caution - Magnolia Street is too narrow to accommodate parade entries and other traffic**

All parade entries must continue to Chestnut St. and proceed to turn right into Brockett Elementary. Parade riders will be dropped off at back entrance to Brockett Elementary once your riders are off their float continue straight to Countryside to exit. Parents picking up participants need to park in the front parking lot of Brockett Elementary and be ready to take their child as they exit the float.

All parade entries will then follow Countryside Dr. to Highmeadow Dr. and return to their homes or places of business by Highway 377. No parade entries will be allowed to drive on Highway 377 with parade riders on floats.

Note: Horse Trailers, etc., should proceed to the pickup area at the Brockett Elementary school BEFORE the parade begins. Main Street Will be CLOSED from 5:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

NO group shall stop nor otherwise slow the parade procession! Caution: Do not Stop on Railroad Tracks.  
Keep Tracks Clear.
